Definition

Connectivity (n): The direct links or associations between multiple things. In city design, connectivity refers to the links between different parts of a city that provide accessibility and easy transport from one area to another. (Source: http://futurecity.org/lb/city/terms) Connectivity describes the network of streets, paths and sidewalk patterns including lengths of segments and the number of intersections.

Example of connectivity




Figure 32. The same trip on a connected street network is often shorter and can avoid busy streets. (Credit: Congress for New Urbanism)
