Frequently Asked Questions:



- When can I visit the property for a site tour?

- How do I reserve my event date?

To reserve your date, email events@delawaregreenways.org to find out if it's available.

- I sent an email inquiry, when can I expect to hear back?

Our goal is to respond to all rental inquiries within 48 hours of receipt. Our team may take a bit longer to respond if your inquiry is received during a wedding or event weekend when our team is on property.

- Are there bathrooms?

Yes! The milk house adjacent to the barn was converted to restrooms. It is a unisex bathroom with three private stalls.

- Is the barn heated or air-conditioned?

No, we're keeping it rustic! Our season for events is May-October. Large ceiling fans create nice air circulation on the upper floor.

- Where are wedding ceremonies held?

Ceremonies are held in the meadow behind the barn and the granary. You can face any direction you choose — towards the sunflowers, granary, or main barn. The rain backup plan is for the ceremony to be held inside the barn on the dance floor area.

- Where do cars park for events?

All wedding packages include valet parking so that we can ensure cars are parked out of main sight lines from the event and guarantee that no one accidentally parks in a planted field. For non-wedding events, up to 50 cars are allowed to self-park. For more than 50 cars, valet is required and is an additional cost.

- Why do I have to have an event planner?

Because Historic Penn Farm does not have an on-site event manager, we require that you work with an event planner to handle logistics and to make your day enjoyable for you and your family. Your event planner must have liability insurance and he or she must be present for your rehearsal, setup, and the entire length of your event.
