Fostina Dixon, multi-instrumentalist, acclaimed recording star, and award-winning artist. Ms. Dixon is a native of Wilmington Delaware where she studied with the late Robert "Boysie" Lowery. She is a composer, vocalist, and jazz soloist who plays soprano, alto and baritone saxes; flute; and clarinet.

Some artists Fostina has worked with include Abbey Lincoln, Gil Evans, Roy Ayers, Tom Browne, Melba Liston, Frank Foster, Prince, and Marvin Gaye, with whom she toured for four years.

She has received a Christi Award for her contributions to promoting the arts in the community, as well as an award from the Council of Jazz Advocates for her work as an arts educator and the Founder and longtime Executive Director of the Wilmington Youth Jazz Band.
